HOW A UNION CAN HELP

Below are some of the Health and Safety & Job Protection measures the USW has been able to negotiate:

For Employees Deemed Essential:

- No mandatory overtime
- Increased sick leave, in some cases up to 14 paid sick days

Health & Safety Measures:

- Staggering start and break times to respect social distancing
- Reducing exposure by using separate doors for entry and exit
- Eliminating the use of punch clocks or allowing a grace period to punch in/out to avoid line-ups
- Moving work stations to allow for six meters between employees
- Dedicating workers for full shifts to sanitizing all common areas
- Allowing employees time at the beginning/end of shift to sanitize their equipment and/or workstation.
- Making sanitizer (for hands and equipment), gloves and masks available to all workers

For Employees on Lay Off:

- Top up pay over and above El benefits
- Ability to work from home
