SOAR is a voice for USW retirees and their families and keeps retirees connected with the union.

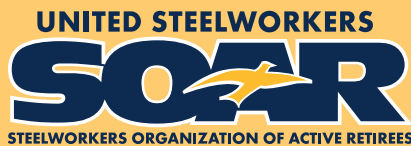
SOAR was established to address the social, economic and political concerns of Steelworker retirees and their families.

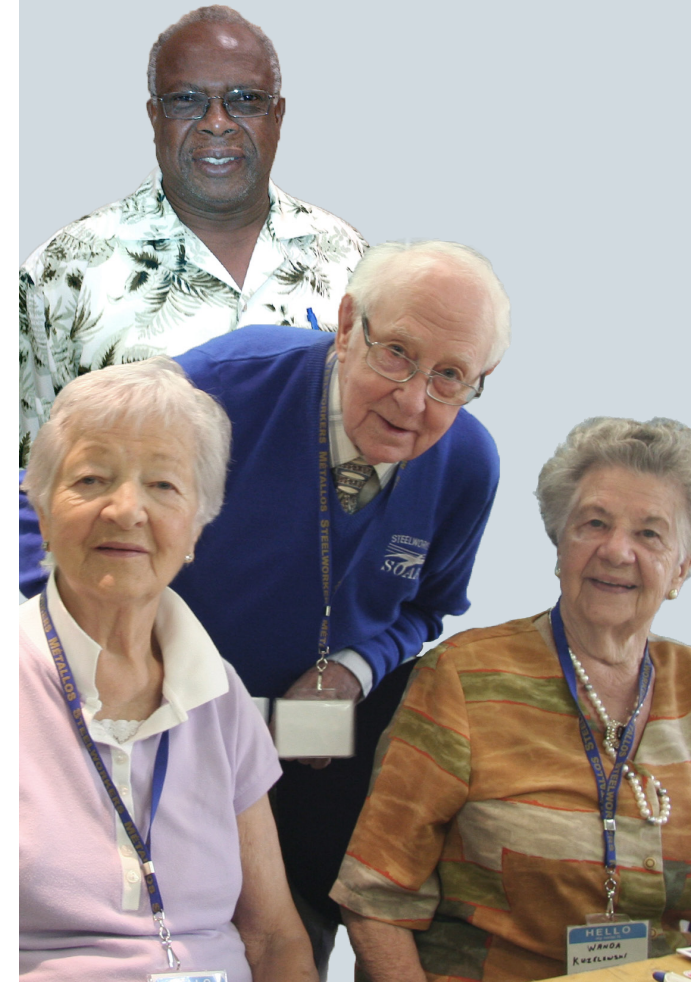
The skills, experience, ideas and energy of USW retirees make our voice heard. Together, we are making a difference and bringing about positive changes by governments and in our communities.
