Strong unions protect good jobs

The NDP is clear: it should be easier to join a union. The NDP fights for workers' rights. The NDP is putting workers first in Trump's trade war with Canada.

Make life more affordable

The NDP is challenging the big grocery chains and demanding that they lower food prices so families can afford their groceries.

Winning new laws for workers

The NDP pushed the government and won:

- An **anti-scab law** for workers in the federal jurisdiction.
- **Pharmacare**, paving the way to universal drug coverage.
- The **Sustainable Jobs Act** puts workers at the table in discussions on climate change.
- **Pension protection**, ensuring pensioners are paid out ahead of others in cases of bankruptcy.
- The Canadian **Dental Care Plan** means seniors and those with household incomes below \$90,000 and no private coverage can get their teeth looked after.
